## NOTIFICATION

The following submission, dated 23 September 2011, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of **the Separate Customs Territory of Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu**. The notification concerns the volume-based special safeguard (**Table MA:3**).

Information required for the calculation of the Trigger Level

Imports in the 3 preceding years:	2007:	1,393.0 tonnes
	2008:	4,031.4 tonnes
	2009:	3,047.6 tonnes
	Average:	2,824.0 tonnes

And the import penetration is taken into account:

Consumption in the 3 preceding years:	2007:	221,151.6 tonnes
	2008:	211,905.4 tonnes
	2009:	219,851.2 tonnes
	Average:	217,636.1 tonnes

Calculation of trigger level (pursuant to Article 5 of the Agreement on Agriculture):

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Import penetration} &= 2,824.0/217,636.1 \\ &= 1.3\% \text{ (base trigger therefore equals 125\%)} \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Trigger level} &= (125\% \times 2,824.0 \text{ tonnes}) \\ &= 3,530.0 \text{ tonnes} \end{aligned}$$

Where the domestic consumption is not taken into account, the trigger level is 3,530.0 tonnes.
